Additionally, further to the discussion during the 88th IMB Meeting on the modification of the framework, the updated mechanism was deliberated upon with the aim to refine existing criteria and incorporate additional dimensions to ensure a structured, transparent, and objective evaluation process by assigning revised weighted scores to key parameters related to innovation, wealth generation, employment, and Make in India Initiative. The detailed scoring framework and SoP were discussed. The IMB members deliberated on the proposed framework and acknowledged its potential to strengthen the evaluation methodology, reduce subjectivity, and capture startup performance.

The IMB may decide or revise the parameters, scores of parameters, weightages of the parameters, as well as the overall score threshold for approval of startup applications. It was

also decided that applications received up to 31st July 2026 shall be evaluated in accordance with the framework approved during the 78th IMB Meeting. Applications received on or after 1st August 2026 shall be evaluated under the modified evaluation criteria.

The approved modified framework is approved for a period of 6 months or until the framework is revised, whichever is earlier.
