Discussion document for States' Startup Ranking 2019

Broad Principles for Ranking 2019

1. The documentary proofs may be expected for minimum compliance on action points. However, they would be pre-requisite for consideration of evaluation committees and further for collecting feedback.
2. More emphasis would be on feedback from actual beneficiaries across all action points.
3. The framework shall be designed to inspire States so that they can target newer and higher goals.
4. Different yardsticks may be used for evaluation for States with mature Startup ecosystems vis-à-vis those who have recently started. The distinction may also be made on the basis of large States and small States.
5. The framework would evaluate progress made from 1st May 2018 to 31st May 2019.
